Why and how are we processing personal data?

The personal data collected through the registration form will be processed for the purpose of organising Who Cares About Sustainable Housing? (HOUSUS) -end seminar and informing about it. Only data that is necessary for organizing the event is collected. Personal data will be collected with your consent (GDPR, Article 6.1a), as well as data on special dietary needs (GDPR, Article 9.2a), in order to take allergies etc. into account in the catering.

What kind of data are we collecting?

We collect:

- Name and email address
- Information about special diet and allergies
- Information about participation in the seminar

We may take photos at the seminar which might be used for reporting on the project.

Who processes your personal data and how long will we retain the data?

Personal data is only processed by employees of Åbo Akademi or people commissioned by Åbo Akademi who need the data to carry out their duties in organising the seminar. Necessary data is kept until the end of the research project or for as long as required by law.

Your personal data will be processed safely and securely in accordance with applicable legislation.

Your personal data will not be disclosed without your consent and will not be transferred outside the European Union (EU) or the European Economic Area (EEA).

How do we protect your personal data?

Data collected in electronic form is stored in IT systems and computers that are protected against unauthorised access, for example by passwords and user IDs. Any data in manual format (paper, etc.) is stored in a locked cabinet in a locked room.

What are your rights?

As your consent is the only legal basis for processing your personal data, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. You can request your withdrawal by sending an email to viena.lahtinen@abo.fi.

Because data is collected about you, you have the right under the GDPR to:

- Be informed about the processing of your personal data
- Have access to personal data concerning you
- Demand that inaccurate data is rectified
- Request the erasure of your personal data
- Restrict the processing of your personal data
- Object to the processing of your personal data
- Have your personal data transferred between systems
- To be informed of a personal data breach which involves a high threat to your data

You have the right to complain to the data protection authorities if you believe that there is an infringement of the General Data Protection Regulation in processing your personal data.
